

Pupil Premium is funding allocated to schools by the government. It is for schools to decide how the Pupil Premium, allocated to schools per FSM pupil, is spent, as they are best placed to assess what additional provision should be made for the individual pupils at their school.

The government allocation of the premium in 2013 – 2014 was £600 per pupil for pupils eligible for Free School Meals (FSM)
