Health and Wellbeing Week

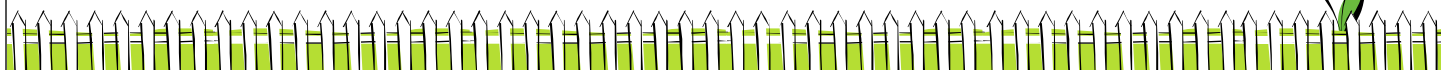
