2. Visit the London Wetland centre and write a report about your visit.
3. Pick the name of an amphibian and write an acrostic or a shape poem. E.g. poisonous dart frog
4. Imagine you are a single 'frogspawn'. What journey lies ahead of you? What is it like to experience the life cycle of a frog at each stage of its metamorphosis? Write a diary entry.

**NOW CHOOSE SOME OR ALL OF THESE**

1. Make a papier mache amphibian/frog life cycle
2. Design your own amphibian top trump cards
3. Draw a detailed frog life cycle diagram
4. Research the most dangerous frogs on the planet and make a warning poster
