Remember to revise your weekly number facts to earn your reward. Think of your rocket to help you!

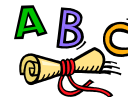

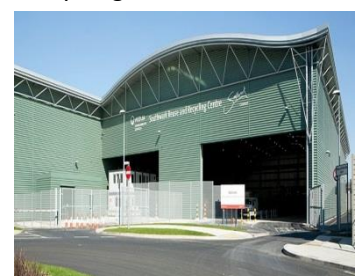
