

Nursery Newsletter 19.10.18

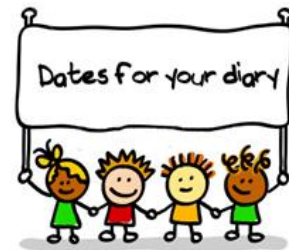

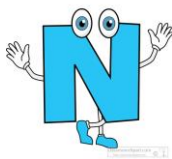
