

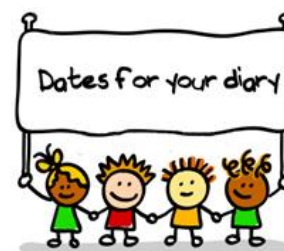

## Getting Dressed

Encouraging your child to dress themselves is a big step towards independence. We ask the children to try to both put on and take off coats and jackets independently during their time in nursery and for this skill to be developed consistently it would be great if you could support this process at home. Even a small start such as putting one sleeve on independently will help. This also helps children to problem solve and feel confident in themselves. Fastenings on coats and shoes may be difficult for the child to manipulate, however an adult can help to get this started and encourage the child to complete the last step such as pulling the zip up.



Please make sure you are checking book bags and diaries weekly and reading with your child daily



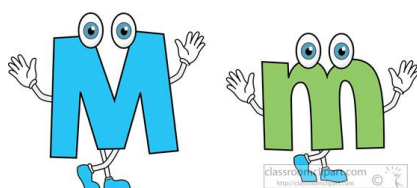
