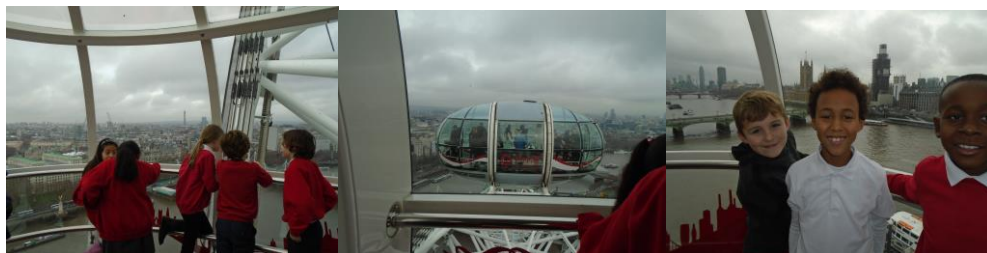


## Science Around the School
