**Topic** - Our topic this half term is **Terrible Tudors!** We will be learning about the Tudors including Henry VIII, clothing, food, famous people and comparing Tudor life to our life today.

**English** - This half term, we will start by reading 'Tar Beach'. We will be focussing on writing a diary entry and a persuasive piece. Later in the term we will be doing some non-fiction writing.

**Maths** - This half term we will be focussing addition and subtraction, length and perimeter and finishing with multiplication. Homework will continue to be uploaded to Google classroom on Fridays and will focus on mental maths strategies and times tables.

**Science** - This half term, we will be learning about Sound.

**R.E** – This half term we will be learning about Hinduism – What is Holi?

**Homework** – This year we will be putting the homework on Google Classroom. Each week there will be a Maths homework, often linked to times tables which may be an interactive activity or questions to answer. The rocket card steps will also be added. Although we will not be testing the children formally on these, we will be working on them in class and it would benefit the children to practise at home. There will also be weekly spellings and the half termly topic homework.
