Dear Children and Adults,

This half term we are learning about the Amazon Rainforest and comparing life in the Amazon to our life here. We will be learning about the geography of the Amazon and finding out about the rainforest habitat and animals that live there.

We do not send out weekly maths homework but we encourage you to use Mathletics at home. All children should have their Mathletics login by now. Please let your child's class teacher know if you're not sure.

Practise reading and writing numbers to 100 ensuring that number are written in the correct orientation. Continue to partition numbers to 50, then to 100. (How many groups of ten and how many extra ones? $46 = 4$ groups of ten and six extra ones)

READING

Remember to read for at least 10 minutes every day! We cannot stress the importance of this enough!

3. Create a collage of an animal or setting from the Amazon
4. Create a 3D model of a boat or aeroplane
