PE

Year 5 PE will take place twice a week. Your child will need to bring a full change of clothes suitable for physical activity, including trainers or plimsolls. Class Teachers will let the classes know which days their PE sessions are and the children should come dressed for PE on those days. If they forget their kit 3 times they will be given a detention. This half-term term both PE sessions will be outdoors – Athletics/ Circuit Training Fitness.

Reading

In year 5 the children are expected to select their own reading books to take home each week. They will be given time during the week to do this and will need to bring back finished books and sign out a new one. All children need to read both independently and with an adult. Please ensure that you sign the children's reading record card when they have read for at least 20 minutes each day. Children will collect stamps in school and will then receive awards for 15 and 30 independent home reads.

Homework

The children will be given maths and spelling homework weekly. A half termly topic homework will also be given out, this has a several creative activities that your child can complete at home.

Mathletics, Rock stars and Reading Eggs

Mathletics, Times table RockStars and Reading Eggs are online programs that can be used at home to support the children's learning in school. Each child was given a log-in and password during the last academic year. If they have lost either or need some additional support using each program then please encourage them to inform us in school.
