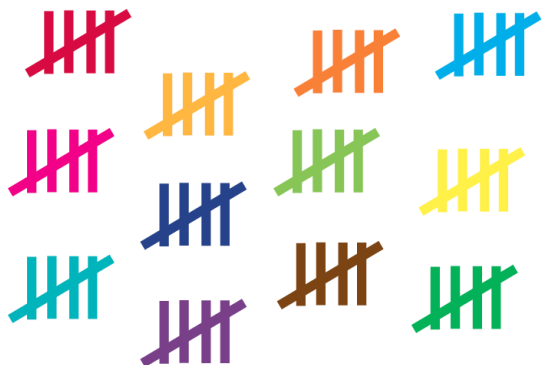


HOME LEARNING
